## School Programs Summer 2013 Internship: Education Kentucky Service Corps AmeriCorps

The Kentucky Historical Society (KHS) is a state agency and membership organization that is fully accredited by the American Alliance of Museums. The KHS mission is to engage people in the exploration of the Commonwealth's diverse heritage by providing connections to the past, perspective on the present and inspiration for the future.

The intern will participate in a 300-hour internship program with the KHS education team. The intern will develop 30-50 instructional units for schools using the KHS collections. These units, aligned with Common Core for English Language Arts and 21<sup>st</sup> Century Learning and Innovation Skills, will include object-, image- and document-analysis activities to be used by teachers in the classroom. Training is provided at the beginning of the internship.

Requirements: Must be currently enrolled in an accredited college or university as an undergraduate (junior or senior standing) or a graduate student. Project is a minimum of 300 hours.

- Training and orientation is in early to mid-May 2013
- Position must be completed by Aug. 31, 2013
- Weekly flexible schedule
- Occasional travel to Frankfort required

This is a temporary position, with an educational voucher offered through AmeriCorps. Employee benefits are not available. Housing is not provided.
