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Fellowship applications are due **at KHS** by **April 1, 2010**, with grantees to be notified by **May 15**. Grantees will be required to provide their Social Security numbers for tax purposes. Because of state regulations, Kentucky state employees are not eligible for these fellowships. (Kentucky public school teachers and state university employees are eligible, however.) Grantees will share their research results for inclusion in the Martin F. Schmidt Library family history files. These materials will become the property of KHS, which retains the right of control and deposition. Fellowship recipients from the previous year are not eligible for fellowships in the same category.
